Much of this requires time away from your work schedule, family, costs associated with the tutorial observation fees, additional training when needed and possible travel and accommodations. Students also benefit greatly from retaking the seminars, although this is not a requirement.

We believe that it is by building and maintaining a strong association of well-trained and competent Certified Practitioners that Resonance Repatterning® will spread and become the household name that we know it can be. Through the certification process you take your basic training in Resonance Repatterning to greater levels of knowledge and skill; through your personal repatterning work, you move to higher states of personal and relationship coherence—both essential to becoming a Certified Practitioner.
